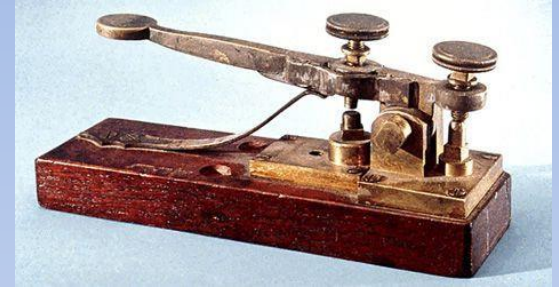

What?



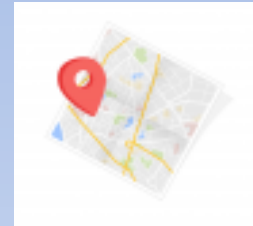
It's used to ask about a thing or an action.

When?



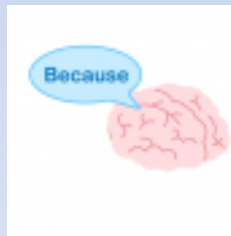
It's used to ask about time or moment.

How?

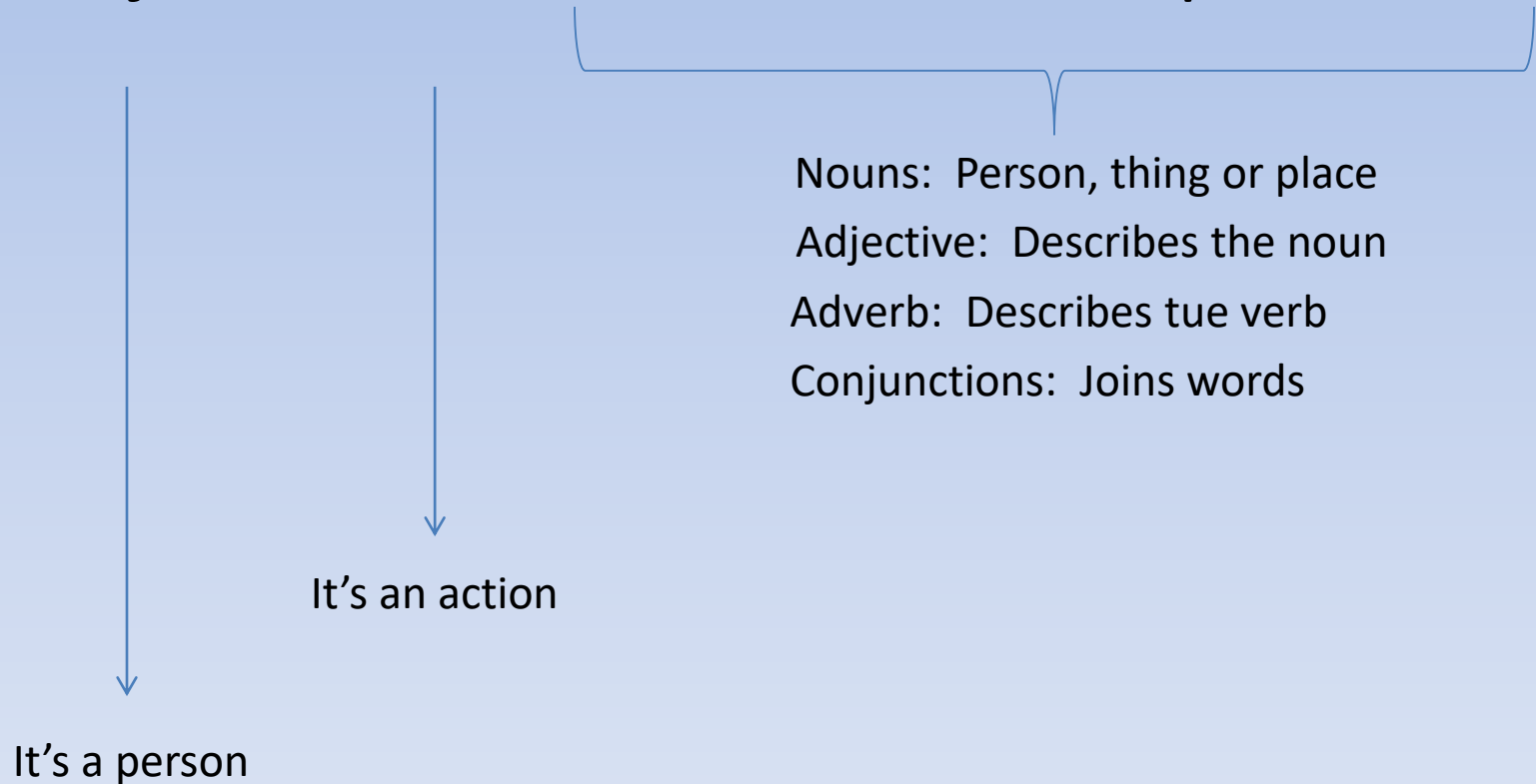


It's used to ask about the way something is.

Grammar: Parts of a sentence

Simple Present Tense

Subject + Verb + Predicate or Complement



Grammar: Past Tense



Regular verb

We add *-ed*

For example:

- * Walk → Walked
- * Use → Used
- * Brush → Brushed
- * Play → Played
- * Study → Studied

Irregular verb

The spelling change

For example:

- * Do → Did
- * Go → Went
- * Drive → Drove
- * Wear → Wore

Past Tense

Regular verbs

Present Tense	Past Tense
Use	Used
Talk	Talked
Walk	Walked
Play	Played
Study	Studied
Chat	Chatted
Brush	Brushed
Travel	Travelled

Past Tense

Irregular verbs

Present Tense	Past Tense
Do	Did
Go	Went
Run	Ran
Swim	Swam
See	Saw
Wear	Wore
Drive	Drove
Eat	Ate
Ride	Rode

Helping verbs and short answers

Verbos Auxiliares y respuestas cortas

We use helping verbs to ask questions in the present and in the past tense.

Usamos los verbos auxiliares para hacer preguntas en tiempo presente y en tiempo pasado.

- Present Tense

We use **Do or Does** to ask questions in the present tense.

For example:

1st and 2nd person (*I/You/We/They*)

Do **I** like English?



Do **You** like English?

Short answers:

Do I like English?

Affirmative → *Yes, I Do*

Negative → *No, I Don't*

3rd person (*She/He/It*)

→ Does **She** like English?

Short answers:

Does He like English?

Affirmative → *Yes, He Does*

Negative → *No, He Doesn't*

- Past Tense

We use **Did** to ask questions in the past tense

1st, 2nd and 3rd → Did **They** study yesterday?

Short answers:

Did I study yesterday?

Affirmative → *Yes, I Did*

Negative → *No, I Didn't*
